The Muscogee (Creek) Nation Department of Health (MCNDH) provides comprehensive health care services to Native Americans living within the Muscogee (Creek) Nation. MCNDH is an integrated system of six health centers, an Express Care Clinic, two hospitals, a physical rehabilitation center and nine comprehensive community health programs Offering services across the lifespan including pediatrics, family medicine, nursing, dental, laboratory, radiology, pharmacy, behavioral health, emergency medical, audiology, nutrition, physical therapy and optometry.

DESCRIPTION OF ASSIGNMENT: The purpose of this position is to provide the Eufaula Health System with supervision of the health information department. This position is located at the Eufaula Indian Health Center in Eufaula, OK.

REQUIREMENTS: Candidates must meet the following requirements:

An Associate's Degree in business communications or a related field **or** graduation from a technical or vo-tech program in a related field of study. A minimum of one (1) year related experience is required. Related experience may substitute for educational requirements and prior experience and knowledge of third party billing.

EVALUATION METHODS: Applicants who meet the requirements described above will be evaluated to determine the extent to which they possess or have the potential to acquire knowledge, skills, abilities and personal characteristics, (KSAP's) required of this position. <u>Applicants should address the following KSAP's on a separate attachment to their application.</u>

- 1. Knowledge of work processes performed by the MCN staff that must use the application programs on multi-user and single user computers.
- 2. Knowledge of OKC/ADP standards, objectives, policies and authorized systems design approaches.
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- 4. Knowledge and ability to train end-users of RPMS applications.
- 5. Knowledge of common business software applications and ability to train end users in desktop applications such as MS Office standard and professional, MS-Forms, MS-WFWG, Win 95 or later versions and MS-Publisher.
- 6. Knowledge of theories, principles, practices and techniques of computer applications and the ability to schedule work processes in an orderly manner.
- 7. Knowledge of ICD-9 and CPT Coding and related information.
- 8. Skill in dealing analytically and systematically with problems of organization, workflow, analysis of data requirements and planning.
- 9. Ability to communicate courteously and effectively both orally and in writing with patients and their families, other MCNDH Staff and the general public.
