The Muscogee (Creek) Nation Department of Health (MCNDH) provides comprehensive health care services to Native Americans living within the Muscogee (Creek) Nation. MCNDH is an integrated system of six health centers, an Express Care Clinic, two hospitals, a physical rehabilitation center and nine comprehensive community health programs Offering services across the lifespan including pediatrics, family medicine, nursing, dental, laboratory, radiology, pharmacy, behavioral health, emergency medical, audiology, nutrition, physical therapy and optometry.

DESCRIPTION OF ASSIGNMENT: The purpose of the position is to aid the Radiologist in performing specific ultrasound examinations as described in the Radiology Department Policies and Procedures. This position is located at the MCN Medical Center located in Okmulgee, OK.

REQUIREMENTS: Candidates must meet the following requirements:

Incumbent must have successfully completed at least a 24-month duration in a post-high school program and be registry eligible as a RDMS and RVT. A minimum of one (1) year relevant experience is preferred. Current RDMS and RVT registry or registry eligible is required.

EVALUATION METHODS: Applicants who meet the requirements described above will be evaluated to determine the extent to which they possess or have the potential to acquire knowledge, skills, abilities and personal characteristics, (KSAP's) required of this position. Applicants should address the following KSAP's on a separate attachment to their application.

1. Knowledge of the physics of Radiology, such as kilo voltage, miliampres and time.
2. Knowledge of human anatomy and physiology.
3. Knowledge of methods, techniques and quality control required for processing digital images with optimum results.
4. Skill in obtaining adequate diagnostic ultrasound results on patients for which normal techniques and methods are not possible, requiring techniques which deviate from the normal.
5. Ability to perform ultrasound examinations and to deal effectively with physicians, staff members and patients and their family members in a courteous and cooperative manner, despite conditions which may sometimes be stressful.
6. Ability to communicate courteously and effectively with Laboratory, medical, and other MCNDH staff, as well as the public, both orally and in writing.
7. Knowledge and skill to establish and modify standard procedures, conduct analysis and evaluation, identify problem areas and resolve the problem.
